THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF DENMARK

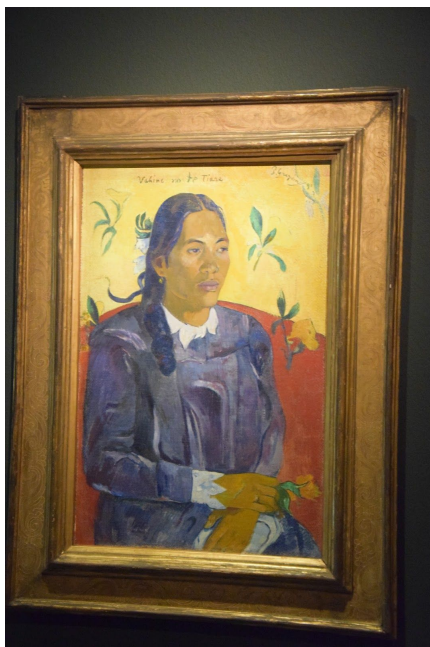

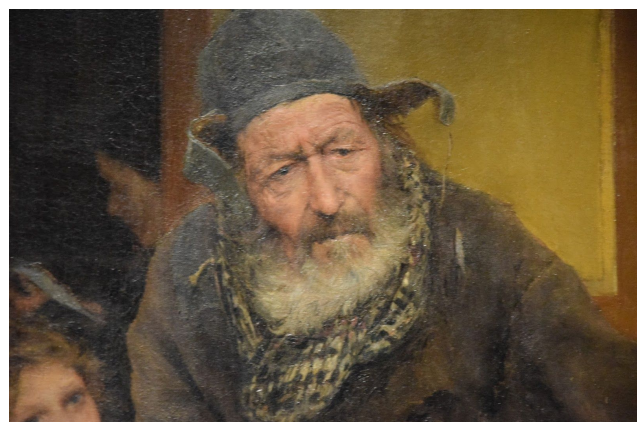


THE GLYPTOTEKET IN COPENHAGEN
